### 3. Comments

3.1) What did you like best about this class?

- A lot of important and informative topics to understand and keep up with AI/ML world. The readings, textbook material, lectures and provided class software were helpful along the way to hands on experience with ML with the final project.
- Homework assignments were relevant to the course content. Professor was accommodating for remote learners and part time students.
- I liked the fact this class was difficult for me. This is my first class back in school and it started with a extremely hard one for me. I like challenge and this class provided it. I often had to spend hours outside of the course to learn and grow. Machine learning has always been something that I have been interested in and this class pushed me forward and I learned quite a bit along the way.
- I liked the pattern of how we learned a new topic: general intro, example/application, algorithm step by step with variables, algorithm step by step with example. The reiteration of the concept really helps.
- Learning and getting exposure to the field of AI and ML was amazing.
- The assignments and the project I worked on because of this course.
- The instructor is very responsive to questions regarding the course materials.
- The instructor showed great knowledge of the field.

3.2) What did you like least about this class?

- Everything else. Professor refused to post powerpoint slides online due to him "owning the content" - shouldn't this be owned by ISU? Also, many lectures simply included other YouTube videos or slides from another source, not original content. Perhaps I misunderstood the course description, so it may be my fault, but this is not what I expected the course to be. In my opinion, far too much time was spent on the mathematical background for different subjects and not enough spent on practical application. The idea of using excel to perform some of these tasks does make it accessible for more students, but very rarely is excel likely to be the chosen "language" in industry, so the

applicability of the content seems low to me.

- I wish there were a few more topics covered in the homework that we covered in class. That way I could really solidify my understanding of the concepts and how some of the algorithms worked.
- Maybe change up the way discussions are done. Maybe reward for replying and continuing the conversation rather than only posting new topics.
- Not getting the in-class experience.
- Often I had to spend hours learning statistics and calculus again since it has been awhile since I have done either of those. I know that was my short coming, but it is still what I liked the least about the course. Overall it was a great course and I would recommend it.
- Sometimes the class was too "mathematical" and I was expecting a more practical approach to the subject. The textbook is a bit difficult to read.
- The complexity of the content was hard to understand many times.
- The material is difficult

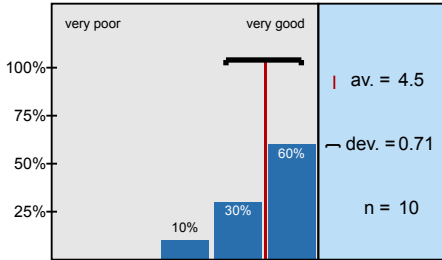

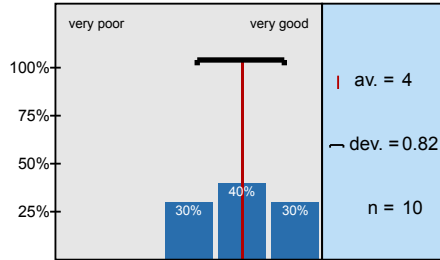
- Great class, great instructor. thanks

# Histogram for scaled questions

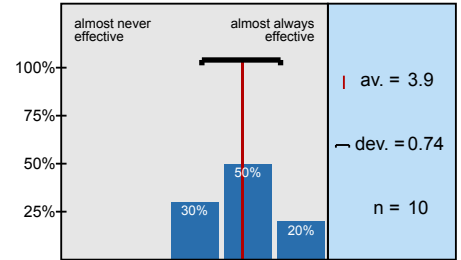
